### Step 2: Get Principal Approval

- Contact school principal(s) for permission
- Complete the Department of General Services (DGS)
   Application to Use Facilities
- Ask host site principal to sign your application



## Step 2: Get Principal Approval REMEMBER:



- FUAs MUST be submitted to DGS by May 3.
- All summer programming MUST operate between June 26, 2024 and July 31, 2024.
- All buildings will be closed July 4, 2024 and July 5, 2024 without exception.

## Step 3: Submit a Facilities Use Agreement Application

Send signed application(s) to the Department of General Services (DGS) Realty Office (<a href="mailto:realty.applications@dc.gov">realty.applications@dc.gov</a>) by <a href="mailto:MAY 3.">MAY 3.</a>

DGS may request a copy of your Certificate of Insurance with DC Government listed as the Certificate Holder and may assign rental, custodial overtime, and/or security fees.

#### **Security Fee Details:**

- Security Services will be provided free of charge when a program operates at a <u>DCPS Summer School site</u> from 8am-4pm.
- Any programming operating outside of 8am-4pm or operating at a non-DCPS summer school site will be subject to standard security service fees.



#### Step 4: Request Food Services

 DC Youth Meals Program provides two meals per day (breakfast, lunch, or snack) on site and free of charge.

You can reserve food services via the <u>Summer 2024 Food Service</u>
 <u>Request Form.</u> Requests must be submitted by May 3.

Food service is available at most schools.
